Holy Week/Easter Opportunities at FUMC

Palm Sunday Worship Services Sunday, April 13 8:30, 9:00 and 11:00 a.m.

On Palm Sunday we celebrate Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, the week before his death and resurrection. It marks the beginning of Holy Week, which concludes on Easter Sunday. The Bible reveals that when Jesus entered Jerusalem, the crowds greeted him by waving palm branches and covering his path with palm branches. Immediately following this great time of celebration in the ministry of Jesus, he begins his journey to the cross.

Before the 11:00 a.m. service all children are invited to meet outside at the entrance to the Fellowship Center foyer to receive palms and then process in together. The Motet Choir will provide special music this Sunday.

Holy Week Luncheons Monday, April 14 through Thursday, April 17

Join us at noon for a staff-led scriptural study in the Social Room. The study will be based on the daily lectionary Bible verses for Holy Week. A light lunch will be available for \$8.00 per plate. Holy Thursday Worship Service Thursday, April 17 7:00 p.m.

In the Fellowship Center

Holy Thursday, also called Maundy Thursday, is a service to commemorate Jesus' Last Supper and the beginning of our sacrament, the Lord's Supper. The word Maundy comes from the Latin mandatum, which means "commandment." At the Last Supper, Jesus gave the disciples a new commandment to love one another as he had loved them (John 13:34). This is the first of the three days of solemn remembrance of the events leading up to and immediately following the crucifixion of Jesus.

Pastor's Perspective

Easter is late in the calendar this year. Not until April 20 will we gather to celebrate God's victory over death in the resurrection of Jesus Christ. This year Holy Week begins on Passion/Palm Sunday April 13. This service will include palms and at the 11:00 a.m. service our Motet Choir will present the gospel story through song. This is also the day Jesus has one of his very last encounters before his death...two criminals crucified with him.

Monday through Thursday of Holy Week the church will gather in the Social Room to eat a meal together and hear a reflection on one of the lectionary texts assigned for that day. We will have a Holy Thursday service at 7:00 p.m. On Good Friday, April 18th, the church will fast and worship will continue with a Good Friday service at 12:10 p.m.

I encourage you to participate in your own journey to the cross. Encounter Christ during Holy Week and stand close as Jesus fulfills his mission to open the door to God, to bridge the gap sin created between all creation and God. We have the opportunity to walk through that door, to cross over that bridge and experience life that is truly life – abundant and grace filled. We can encounter God. Do not allow this opportunity to pass you by.

I have been asked to share the following report that I prepared for our last Administrative Board Meeting. Some things need to be shared in order to motivate, inspire, or remind us of where we are and where we should be or where we are heading!



My Vision for MYF

Why do I always look like I'm in a hurry? It's not because I'm too busy, it's because I have an internal urgency that won't let me slow down. I read somewhere that from the time a child is born until they graduate from high school, there are only 940 weekends for them to attend church. I know right? It sounds like a lot, but it's not, especially when they only attend one or two hours per week to establish their Spiritual Journey. If a child is in kindergarten they only have 635 weekends left; in 3rd grade there are 468 left; in 5th grade there are 363 left; and in 9th grade there are only 206 Sundays left! It all happens too fast! And that is my urgency; to help our students discover and embrace a growing relationship with Jesus Christ. My vision for MYF is for them to graduate knowing three things: 1) They can trust God no matter what; 2) They need to make the wise choice - God first; and 3) They should treat others the way they want to be treated – with love and compassion. How can I possibly do that? By spending as much time with them on Sunday nights, Wednesday nights, weekend events, Sunday mornings, and at camps. I want to make sure they know that the Bible is the source of wisdom and truth and what they learn from it, it applies to their daily lives. And I also want for them to know that their Church Family and peers will be the most important relationships they will ever have.

My hope for MYF is to be able to equip them to reach UP, IN, and OUT just like Jesus did. He reached up to God, reached in to his disciples, and reached out to all the people in need. This is definitely a big task, but together it can be done, especially with the help of parents and grandparents. Parents and grandparents are the number one example that students notice and imitate. Together we can guide our students to get into a rhythm of love; love for Christ, love for our church, and love for others.

Our Youth Ministry is hungry for the truth; we just have to be available and present.


