Pastor's Perspective LOVE GOD, SHARE JESUS, GROW FAITH

Love God...Share Jesus...Grow Faith. I've spend much time talking about these six words the last few weeks. A blessing of having a study leave was I attended worship at different churches. Experiencing these church families helped to crystalize in my heart and mind what we do as the First United Methodist Church family. I filtered my experience of other churches through the lens of what we do as church, how we do what we do and why we do what we do. Six words (three phrases) that distill what we as church strive and strain to do to the glory of God formed in my mind. Let me say a word about each phrase.

LOVE GOD. Pharisees asked Jesus which commandment was the greatest. Jesus said to love God with all your heart, soul and mind. Striving to love God in all we do is fulfilling what Jesus said was most important.

SHARE JESUS. Jesus added an additional commandment that he said was like the first, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." (Matthew 22:34-40) Loving your neighbor as yourself involves acts of mercy, loving-kindness and treating neighbors as you want to be treated. But, the most loving thing you can do for your neighbor is to share with them the gift of Jesus. That is the gift that has eternal rewards.

GROW FAITH. Our mission as United Methodists is to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. While it is God who makes it possible for people to receive and have faith, we are expected to provide an environment that makes it possible for faith to grow, flourish and be fruitful. Faith becomes fruitful (disciples are created) when it leads people to claim Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.

I hope you've been able to see the videos we are showing each week in worship that show how we are loving God, sharing Jesus and growing faith through the ministries of our church. There is a link
