**Things to bring** depend on your teams 'toolness'. We need people with no tools but willing hands to work "Home in a Week" will have tools for these folk.

- For people with basic tools (circular saw, tool belt,) bring them.
- For people with lots of tools: we can use any and all pneumatic nailers (framing first then finishing) with compressors and hoses.
- We will need scaffolding for the entire home; about 12 sets.
- Any and all tools related to sheetrock install and floating. Any and all cordless tools, drills, saws, sawzall.
- Compound Miter saws with stands.
- We have a temporary elec. box with 24 plugs to handle almost anything. We have a laser level and a table saw.
