





Pearls of Wellness Wisdom

March is colorectal cancer awareness month. Learning some basic facts is important. Colorectal cancer is the fourth most common cancer in the United States and the second leading cause of death from cancer. Colorectal cancer affects people in all racial and ethnic groups and is most often found in people age 50 and older. Several lifestyle-related factors have been linked to colorectal cancer. These include being overweight or obese, physical inactivity, certain types of diets that are high in red meats and processed meats, or cooking meats at very high temperatures such as frying, broiling, or grilling which creates chemicals that might raise your cancer risk, smoking and heavy alcohol use. There are some risk factors you cannot change which include being older, a personal history of colorectal polyps, colorectal cancer, or inflammatory bowel disease, and a family history of colorectal cancer or adenomatous

The good news? If everyone age 50 and older were screened regularly, 6 out of 10 deaths from colorectal cancer could be prevented. Communities, health professionals, and families can work together to encourage people to get screened. Some screening tests may include the guaiac-based fecal occult blood test (gFOBT), colonoscopy and/or a flexible sigmoidoscopy. When detected at an early stage before it has spread, the 5-year relative survival rate is about 90%. But only about 4 out of 10 colorectal cancers are found at this early stage. When cancer has spread outside the colon or rectum, survival rates are lower. Part of the prevention includes leading an active lifestyle as exercise may help reduce the risk of colorectal cancer. CORNERSTONE/Texas Ramp Project MINISTRY

Friday a.m. & Saturday a.m. • March 3 & 4, 2017

Friday & Saturday, March 3rd & 4th mark dates of First UMC CORNERSTONE MINISTRY 2017. This ministry has evolved over the past 26 years into one that serves primarily physically challenged individuals and their families with wheelchair ramps. Last year, we successfully partnered with Texas Ramp Project (TRP). We are excited to announce leaders of the Cornerstone Ministry have agreed that First UMC will be

officially considered a TRP site. We will be responsible for seeing that at least 8 ramps in our area are built per year. During Cornerstone weekend we are hoping to build 6. TRP will assist us with some funding for the ramps. We have several Cornerstone leaders trained in building TRP model ramps.

One aspect that is different in the TRP model of building the ramps, is the length of time it will take to build it. It takes approximately 4 hours to build each ramp. So we will be working in the earlier part of the day with the goal of being completed by lunchtime or shortly after.
